## Tour Overview:

The hamlet of Sungai Lembing, once known as the El Dorado of the East, has seen a glorious past. It is situated north-west of Kuantan, Pahang. The town was famous for its land rich in subterranean tin deposits and believed to be one of the largest and the deepest underground tin mines in the world. Today, Sungai Lembing has become a township only with the "diehard."

Explore this quaint town - referred to as 'cowboy town' by the locals, visit the tin-mine museum which contains a collection of mining artifacts and see how the locals still use the high hanging bridge to cross the river during the rainy season. Visit the old market square, see the Chinese clan houses and the surrounding. Pop into a home bakery, still using wood-fired ovens for making buns, coconut biscuits, cakes and "coffee-cROUTONS"
